- Ideally: ANYTHING would be delivered already as PDF/A document to the archive
- Process change and MID to LONG TERM task
- Sample: State Archive Hamburg has employees which consult "document suppliers" on preparing documents for the turnover to the state archive.
- Archives can (should) require PDF/A formats
- Conversion of existing documents under cost-benefit aspects

- LONG TERM ARCHIVING
- Meta data!



- Digital Master (= lossless scans e.g. as JPEG2000)
- Content delivery (via Internet)
- Exploitation (= download and sale)
- Paper: Retroperspective digitization
- Digital: "Digital born" books
