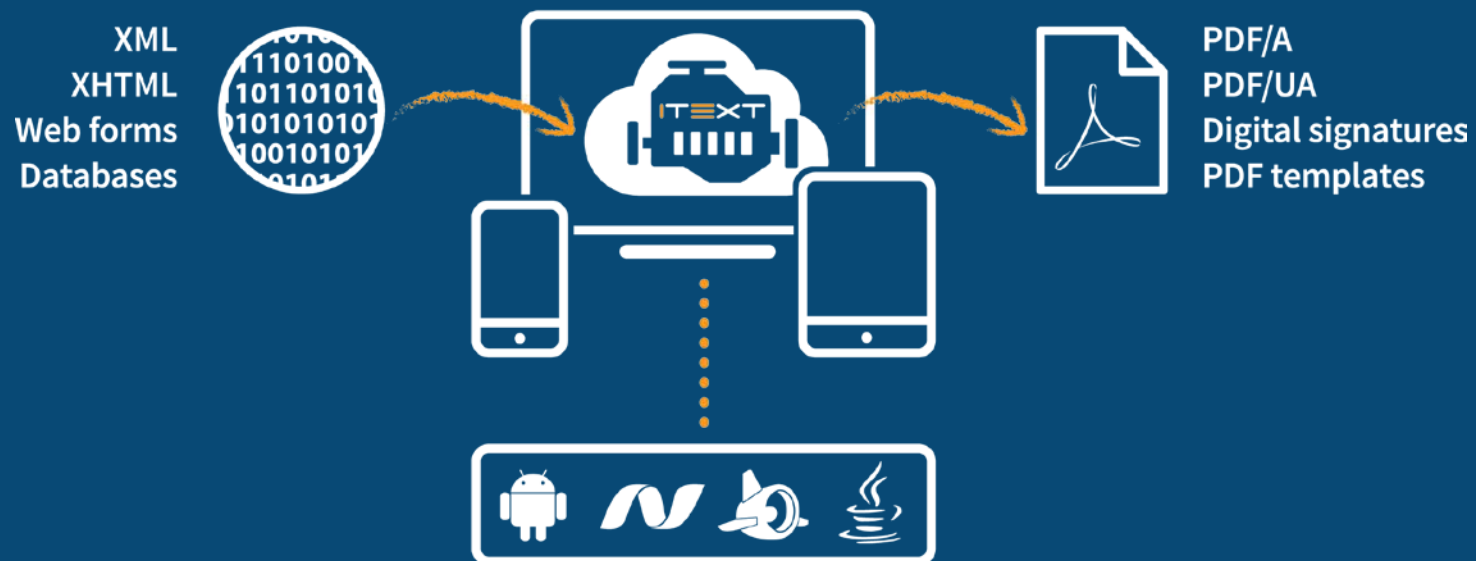


The current ways are insufficient

iText: A better way to generate PDF



≡ Incorporating directly into your software, web portal or application

- iText is used to create PDF documents programmatically, with or without minimal human intervention

≡ Using a developer library

- Does not require special knowledge of PDF
- Code that doesn't have to be written can be implemented much faster
- Available for Java, .NET, Android and GAE
